3. Spelling GUIDE. Let's use INFER and IMPLY correctly. To infer means "to conclude by reasoning from something known or assumed", whereas to imply means "to indicate without saying openly" EXAMPLE: "Although Chief FLO 4's implied Chief BLACK was a heavy skeet shooter, there was no mistaking his inference concerning JCR S. 001!"
