"To convey the history of the American Naval presence in Villefranche-sur-Mer to all people and especially to the younger and future generations."

The upcoming installation in September of our permanent Historic exhibit aboard the USS Little Rock CLG-4 (during our Reunion) is just the start of many projects here in the U.S. designed to fulfill our mission. To that end, we are pleased to announce our next event:

We are planning a long weekend of remembrances and fun tours, along with the unveiling of our permanent exhibit. 

Thursday, September 12, 2024 1:00 PM - 5:00 PM Welcome Aboard

"Welcome Aboard" will be held in the McKinley Room. It will be open for you to check in to the reunion. Here you will receive a Welcome packet that contains your name badge, tickets for meals and tours you purchased, and a program of all events.

7:00 PM Welcome Reception

We will meet in the **ClevelandRoom** for our Welcome Reception. We will be entertained by the Red Blazer Men's Chorus.

Come and meet your fellow **Shipmates and Members**. It will be an opportunity to share "Sea" Stories or your memories and experiences of your time in Villefranche and being part of the 6th Fleet.

9:00 AM - 3:00 PM Niagara State Park

Buses will depart hotel for **NiagaraStatePark**, the oldest state park in the United States. At the park we will board the park trolley. The trolley will take you on a narrated tour of the park. Or if you prefer, you can get off and on the trolley at any of the stops within the park.

On your own you can visit the Maid of Mist, Cave of the Winds, Observation Bridge, or take the Free Hop OnHop Off Shuttlethat will take you to 17 stops in the area outside of the park -- From the Falls to Fort Niagara."

Lunch is on your own. There are several restaurants just across from visitors center on Niagara Street. Just be sure to be where the bus dropped you off to catch the bus back to the hotel by 3:00 PM.

We will meet in the **Cleveland/Filmore Room** where we will enjoy a lovely supper with our fellow Members, Shipmates and guests. Entertainment by Buffalo Swing and Jazz.

Shuttle Bus service to Buffalo and Erie County Naval Park. Shuttles will leave the hotel at 9:00 AM, 9:45AM and 10:15 AM. Those on the earlier buses will have the opportunity to tour the park prior to the celebration and others will tour it after the reception.

11:00 AM Unveiling Ceremony of Permanent Exhibit

A historical timeline depicting the partnership of the U.S. and French Navies from 1777 to present will be unveiled aboard the U.S.S. Little Rock CLG-4.

Following this unveiling we will be shuttled to Chef's Restaurant for a Cocktail and Hors d'Oeuvres reception.

The shuttle bus will then take you back to the park and waterfront to tour on your own. If you have not been to Buffalo in the past 3 years you will be amazed at its transformation. If you prefer, you may ride the shuttle bus back to the hotel. The last bus will leave the Buffalo & Erie County Naval & Military Park at 3:30 PM.

WHAT HAPPENS AT A REUNION? We want you to enjoy yourself from the first day of the reunion. We do <u>not</u> separate wives and hubbies. Our activities are chosen to appeal to everyone, and serve to promote conversation and maximize reminiscing. We have activities for the early arrivals on Thursday night; and organized tours on Friday and Saturday. The highlight of this Reunion will be the Unveiling of a Permanent display aboard the U.S.S. Little Rock CLG-4. We have group meals where a lot of "catching up" takes place as you break bread with your Shipmates.

What to wear? Most events, other than the banquet, are fun, casual affairs, and we dress accordingly. Our Saturday night banquet is a full-fledged program with a head table, guest speaker(s), color guard, a dance floor and band. Some of us dress up for the banquet. Military officers can wear dress uniforms. Attendees can wear casual dress, sport coats or suits, ladies can wear dresses or slacks.

HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NOW...

First, you must register with us for meals and tours. You can participate in as many or as few activities as you wish. Pick out those functions you wish to attend, and add in those fees as shown. We must commit—with hard numbers—to the hotel and tour operators long before the events, then we're obligated to pay for the number we provided. To know that number, we must have your Registration information well in advance of the event. Please fill out the Registration worksheet now.

Note that the Registration Fee covers the costs of holding a reunion in somewhere other than a phone booth or on a park bench with a Hello My Name Is... thingy stuck on your shirt. Each attendee receives a memento of the reunion. So, add in the Registration Fee for the Shipmate/Member, plus the Guest Registration fee for each person over the age of 5 accompanying the Shipmate/Member. (Don't count the Shipmate/Member as a guest.) Registration fees for walk-ins at the reunion are increased as shown because they trigger a considerable chain of events. The registration fee is nonrefundable. If your 2024 U.S. 6th Fleet in VSM Membership dues are unpaid, please pay it now. If you want to join the U.S. 6th Fleet in VSM organization here in the United States you can do that also by adding your Membership dues to this Registration form now! Please write new next to it.

(All Ship membership dues should be paid to their respective organizations, do not pay them here!).

"Early Birds" who register with us (*meaning, Registration form and payment in full*) by **August1, 2024** will become eligible for an entry into a drawing at the reunion, where they can win one of their nights at the host hotel **free** (if they're staying at the hotel). Be the first to sign up. Send this form and your check to the address shown on the other side of this form.

Next, you register with the host hotel for your room accommodations. We always negotiate our hotel rates to run three days before the reunion to three days after the reunion. Naturally, you can stay elsewhere, but attendees who do this *once* invariably tell us that they missed out on much of the camaraderie and socializing. In most cases you won't find a <u>comparable</u> hotel at a cheaper rate.

The reunion hotel is the **M Hotel, 2040 Walden Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14225.** The phone number **1-888-216-8447** and you must identify your affiliation with the **U.S. 6th Fleet**. use the group code 0799AFC770

The room rate for this reunion is \$139.00 (<u>plus tax</u>) per room per night (if you reserve by **August 10, 2024**). This includes a Buffet Breakfast for 2 for every night you stay in the hotel including Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The entire hotel (*like most in the country*) is **NON-SMOKING**. Check in time is 3:00 PM, checkout time is 11:00 AM. Hotel parking is free. Dead parking for RVs is allowed (*no power and no occupancy*) but you should get prior approval. Be advised that cancellation of room in less than 72 hours of check in or early checkout penalty is one night's rental fee (\$139.00 + tax).

We have a Welcome Aboard team that will have a package in your name at the hotel. This package will contain your name tags, a program and complete itinerary, meal and tour tickets for the activities that you selected, gift checks to redeem, and other information. **Welcome Aboard** will be set up for this reunion starting at **1:00pm to 4:30pm** on Thursday in the **McKinley Room**. The program that you receive at the reunion will give you the times for the various events. *Please make your plans so that you arrive a at least 15 minutes before any scheduled event.*

The hotel desk people will know where our 6th Fleet folks are. Much of our socializing will be in the **Cleveland Room**. This is where you'll run into your old Shipmates. It's also here that you'll be able to buy many Ship Store items such as coffee cups, hats, challenge coins tee shirts, etc. from the various ships attending as well as 6th Fleet identity items like Challenge Coins, key chains, Hats, etc. all with their logo's on them.

About Cancellations... If something comes up and you're forced to cancel your reunion attendance, call us as soon as possible at **508-580-3808**. We can send you a refund **IF** you advise us early enough for us to modify our counts to the hotel and tours, which means **in our hands at least thirty days prior to the reunion**. If you cancel after that, we are still obligated to pay for the contracted functions, so there can be no refund. Another reason why it's important to notify us ASAP is that if you call too late, we might be on the road and may not get that message until it is too late.
